Stevens, M., & Young, M. (2009).

The current report provides a nationwide assessment of the correlates of reported gambling problems amongst the Indigenous population. More specifically, it advances Gambling Research Australia's fourth priority research area by: 1. Conducting a literature review on gambling and Indigenous people, 2. Examining the extent to which gambling problems are related to experience of other negative life events (stressors), and 3. Identifying the independent correlates of reported gambling problems.

Individuals whose lives have been impacted by problem gambling and would like the opportunity to tell their story and express their views are also welcome.
